Festival Rules and Regulations

Thank you for participating in MainStreet's Annual Dog Daze at the Landing, on October 19, 2002 at the Fort Walton Beach Landing. In order to provide for your safety and the safety of others, we ask that you abide by the following rules: Please initial next to each entry to indicate you understand and will abide by each rule/regulation.

1. 1. _____ BOOTH FEE: (See application) Please make sure your equipment fits within the space size you have indicated. Your space size should include your tie-downs, tarps, flaps, tables, trailer tongues, side openings, etc.
2. _____ Booth spaces will be mapped out prior to the event. You will be notified of set-up times and locations. No booths will be allowed to set up early.
3. _____ Be prepared to open promptly at 10 a.m. and close by 5 p.m on Saturday, October 19, 2002. Should your booth require special lighting, you will provide that lighting.
4. _____ Booths must be taken down, removed and **your area cleaned up** by Sunday, October 20, 2002 at 10:00 a.m. All cleaning deposits will be promptly returned to you once the area has been checked by the Dog Daze Committee.
5. _____ Private vehicles will be permitted into the booth area for loading and unloading equipment until one hour prior to opening. Other loading and unloading is allowed after festival hours ONLY. Vendors must park in the designated vendor parking are. **THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
6. _____ People having food and drink booths must provide a minimum of two-30 gallon garbage containers with liners. **Each booth will be responsible for emptying the container, on a regular basis, into the dumpsters provided by the Festival. Cleanliness in and around your booth will be your own responsibility.**
7. _____ If your booth requires electricity, accurately indicate your amperage requirements on the application form to assure that the Festival can make proper preparations. Each booth requiring electricity will be responsible for not overloading their circuit. All electrical connections and equipment must be in good repair and properly grounded. **If electricity is needed at your booth, you must supply an appropriate (120v or 220 v) 150-foot heavy duty, all weather extension cord.**
8. _____ Any booth which will be using any type of oven, grill, deep-fat fryer, flame operated appliance, or heating element, will be required to have a minimum of a charged 40BC fire extinguisher. The FWB Fire Department will be on-site Saturday morning for inspection.
9. _____ If water is required for your booth, you must provide a 100' water hose.
10. _____ Booth waste water and cooking grease **MUST** be contained.
11. _____ Any booth having live animals on site are responsible for having each animal on a lease or in a cage at all times as well have having proof of each animal's current rabies vaccination. By initialing here, you are accepting complete responsibility for every animal you bring to the Festival. MainStreet of Fort Walton Beach, the City of Fort Walton Beach and the Emerald Coast Kennel Club are not liable in any way for any injuries or damage caused by your animals, during the entire time you are on the Fort Walton Beach Landing property.
12. _____ All vendors are responsible for collecting and remitting all 6% sales tax to the State of Florida.
13. _____ No alcoholic beverages will be permitted for consumption or for sale during this Festival.
